# Homeownership by Race and Hispanic Origin (2015)

In 2015, the median wealth of a homeowner was \$195,400, compared to just \$5,400 for a renter according to the Federal Reserve. While nearly 72% of White households nationwide owned their own homes, only 45% of Hispanic or Latino and 42% of African-American households were homeowners.
